Our Standards – Student Outcomes

We are a very high achieving school both locally and nationally. We are consistently one of the highest performing schools in Cheshire East and in the top 25% of schools nationally.



For example, the percentage of pupils gaining a Grade 4 or better in English and Maths, or Grade 5 or better in English and Maths in recent years are both 15% above the figures for Cheshire East and over 20% above national figures. In addition, our Progress 8 scores over time are very impressive, consistently putting us in the top 25% of schools nationally. We are extremely proud of our exam results at GCSE and A level every year (*see our website for further details*).

Any child that really works with us will achieve their best possible results at Alsager School. We encourage, support, advise and help every pupil to achieve the 'best' they possibly can.
