Our Curriculum

At Egerton, we aim to provide a curriculum which enables all children to make progress and attain exceptional outcomes. Knowledge and skills are carefully planned and sequenced so that our children's prior learning is built on and through the application of key skills, used and applied. We aim to provide all of our children with the skills and knowledge to enable them to thrive and flourish in whichever pathway they choose for their future.

Our curriculum is broad, balanced and enriched with a strong approach to global learning including the teaching of Spanish from Year 1 to Year 6 and the work of our partnership with Egerton Primary School in Kenya. Alongside this learning children engage in Forest School, residential visits to Wales and Burwardsley, and carefully thought out trips connected to the school's curriculum.

We are a Gold Rights Respecting School and also a Primary Science Award holder. These very high accolades demonstrate the wonderful curriculum offer we have here at Egerton.



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Egerton Nursery

Egerton Nursery (formerly Egerton Pre-School) offers nursery provision for 2-4 year olds with its own facilities in the school grounds.

At the Nursery the staff provide a physically and emotionally safe environment for our children, where they can develop their confidence and independence. We offer excellent learning opportunities, which result in self-motivated and happy children, who learn through play and having fun.

The structure of our day is planned to encourage self-confidence, independence and group co-operation through large group, small group and one to one activities. We provide and promote learning opportunities to support all seven areas of learning, enabling your child to have the skills they need, for their next learning journey.

Our before and after school club, Egerton Lions, provides a safe and secure and relaxed environment, offering a range of activities to reflect the interests of the children in our care. The club's ethos replicates that of the school and has a strong focus on respect.

Our Club follows the Play work Principles, so the children are free to choose activities and resources as they wish. There will always be a selection of activities and resources available, including dressing up, home corner, craft, board games, construction, iPads, physical outdoor play, and reading. In addition, other resources such as baking/cooking will be offered on occasions.

We provide cereal, toast and a selection of preserves in the morning. In the evening we offer a light after school tea such as pasta and filled wraps. We recognise the importance of healthy nutrition for children delivered in a calm, friendly setting.
